Approving the Layout

Are the color matches that are called out accurate?

Wall/Finished Graphic Size
Items in blue indicate the finished graphic size, or in the case of wallcovering, the actual field verified wall dimensions.

Panel ID
This shows the letter designation of the panel or graphic. This can be used by installers as a guide for installation

Bleed + Overlap
This describes the amount of extra bleed that will print and any overlap between panels for wallcovering
